Selection Words

Students should learn to recognize and define the words from the story.

drum- A *drum* is a musical instrument that makes a sound when it is beaten. A *drum* is hollow with a cover stretched tight over either or both ends.

clattering – making a noise like plates or silverware striking together.

voice- Your *voice* is the sound you make with your mouth. You use your *voice* when you speak, sing, or shout.

jingles- to make or cause to make sounds like bells

silver- *Silver* is a shiny white metal. *Silver* is used to make coins, jewelry, and other things.
